INFORMATION ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA

1. What personal data do we process and where do we collect them

- a) Identity and communication details (name, surname, father's name, Social Security Number, home address, phone number, e-mail address).
- b) Data and information regarding your health status and your medical history.

2. What are the purpose and the legal basis for processing your personal data

- a) Communication with you on topics related to your appointments, examinations, diagnosis and treatment
- b) The performance, evaluation and report of your medical examinations
- c) The delivery of your test results
- d) The coverage of the cost of services by Social Insurance Institutions
- e) The issuance of required tax documents

The legal basis for these purposes is consisting of:

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- a) The necessity of processing your personal data for your medical diagnosis and treatment, as well as the contract between us for the provision of services to you.
- b) The necessity of fulfilling obligations and exercising rights in the field of social security and social protection law, as well as the terms of the relevant contracts.
- c) Compliance with the applicable tax legislation, which requires the collection of your data for the issue of a legal document.
- d) The preservation and protection of your legitimate interests as well as of ours.

3. Who are the recipients of your personal data

The Laboratory may transfer personal data to third parties to whom it assigns the processing of your personal data on its behalf (for specialized medical examinations requiring analysis by specialized laboratories). In these cases, the Lab will remain responsible for the processing of your personal data, it will specify the details of the processing, and it will sign a specific contract with the third parties to whom it assigns the processing activities in order to ensure that the processing is carried out in accordance with the applicable legal framework.

We also notify - when required - your data to the relevant tax authorities and social insurance organizations.

Only upon your order may your personal data be transferred to third parties (eg treating physician) or to persons you indicate.

The Laboratory will not transfer your data to a third country or an international organization except with your permission and subject to the conditions of the applicable legislation

4. For how long do we keep your personal data

According to Article 14 of the Code of Medical Ethics (C. 3418/2005), medical records are kept for 10 years from your last visit to the Lab, unless guidelines from competent scientific associations set time extension.

5. What are your rights with respect to your personal data

You may exercise at any time at your request in our Lab, the following rights regarding your personal data:

- a) **Right of access**, that is to ask us which of your personal data do we process, for what purposes, if we give them to third parties and to whom, as well as other relevant information. You also have the right to receive a free copy of your personal data at your request.
- b) **Right to rectification** of your personal data
- c) **Right to the erasure** of your personal data: (i) when your personal data are no longer necessary in relation to the purposes for which they were collected, (ii) when you withdraw consent on which the processing of your personal data is based and there is no other legal ground for the processing, (iii) when your personal data were processed without the existence of the required legitimate grounds
- d) **Right to restriction of the processing** of your personal data
- e) **Right to data portability**, that is to send your data in an appropriate electronic media, and / or in paper form, to you, or to a person you will suggest, or to another controller.
- f) **Right to withdraw** at any time the consent you have given for a matter relating to the protection of personal data and health data.
